- Roll out progressively from end-2026

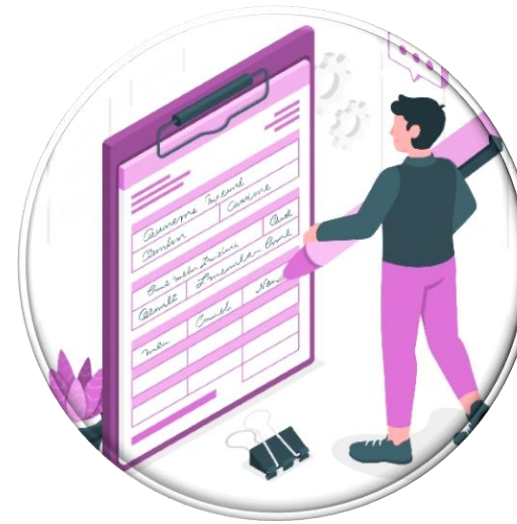

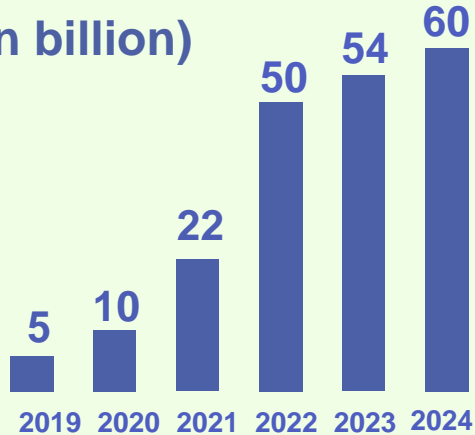

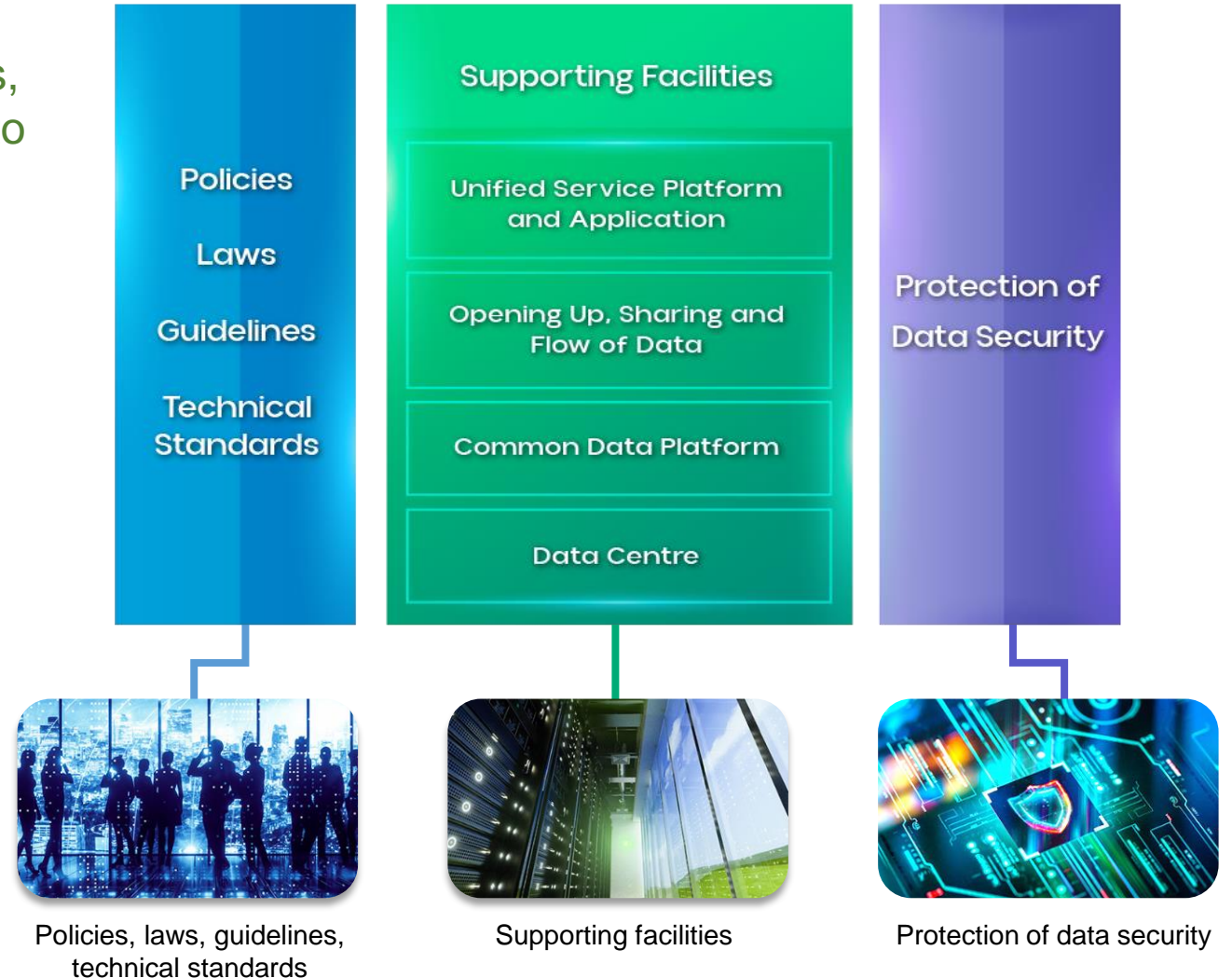


- Published by ITIB in Dec 2023

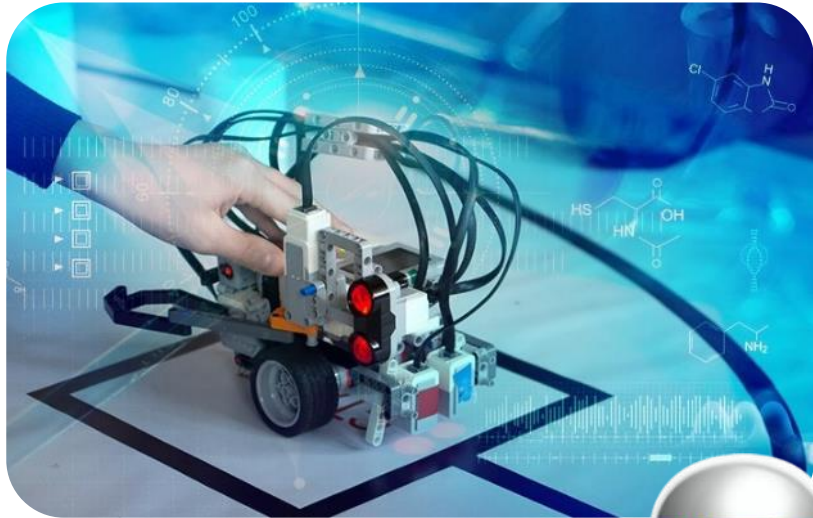
Promote STEAM Education



- Establish the Steering Committee on Strategic Development of Digital Education
- Renew junior secondary Science curriculum
- Launch a pilot scheme to promote AI-assisted teaching in junior secondary Science subject
- Host an international summit and workshop series on use of AI
- Collaborate with I&T organisations and tertiary institutions to provide professional training to STEAM coordinators and teachers
- Strengthen professional development programmes and onsite support services for IT in education



STEM Internship Scheme



- Provide short-term internship positions to undergraduates and post-graduates taking STEM-related programmes
- Foster students' early interest in pursuing a career in I&T after graduation
- Enriching Hong Kong's talent pool
- Expand the number of student interns from 3 000 in 2022 to 5 000 in 2027



Digital Transformation Support Pilot Programme

Expediting the pace of digital transformation of SMEs

- \$500 million for Cyberport to launch the Programme
- Funding support to SMEs on a 1:1 matching basis
- Adopting easy to use off-the-shelf digital solutions
- **Up to \$50,000** for each eligible SME for acquiring digital solution packages
- Anticipated to benefit **8 000+ SMEs**

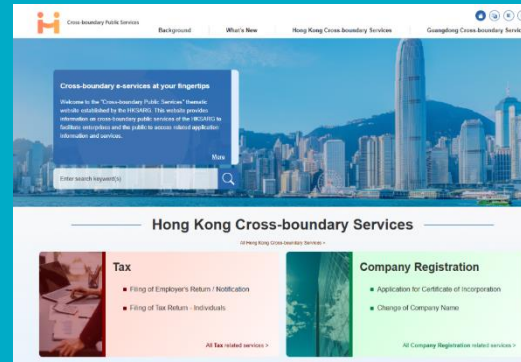

The “Standard Contract for Cross-Boundary Flow of Personal Information within the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (Mainland, Hong Kong)” (“The GBA Standard Contract”)

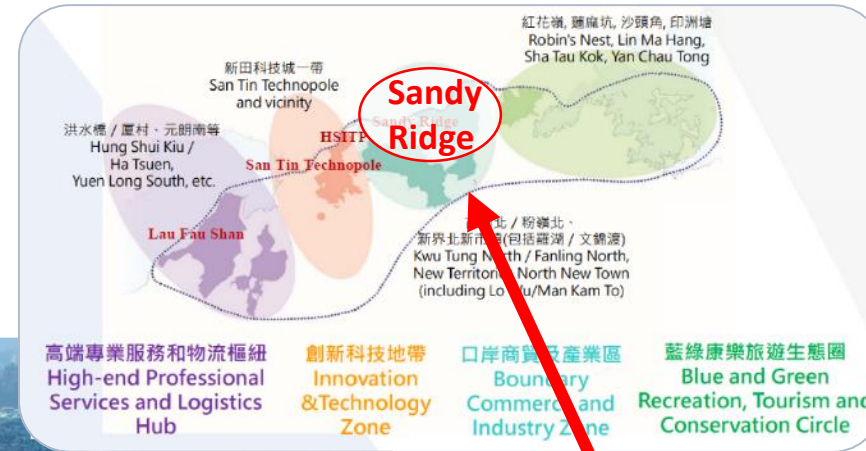


- On 29 Jun 2023, signed the “Memorandum of Understanding on Facilitating Cross-boundary Data Flow within the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area” in Beijing
- On 13 Dec 2023, jointly announced the GBA Standard Contract facilitation measure and pilot adoption (先行先試) in three sectors
- On 1 Nov 2024, announced all sectors in nine GBA mainland cities and Hong Kong can adopt the GBA Standard Contract to conduct cross-boundary flow of personal data within GBA

Develop new quality productive forces

- Formulate medium to long-term development plan for new industrialisation in Hong Kong, and facilitate the establishment of the Hong Kong New Industrialisation Development Alliance to promote collaboration among the Government, industry, academia, research and investment sectors
- Take forward the third InnoHK research cluster with focuses on advanced manufacturing, materials, energy and sustainable development
- Increase investment for research and innovation and technology (I&T) industries
 - Set up a \$10 billion I&T Industry-Oriented Fund to form a fund-of-funds to channel more market capital to invest in specified emerging and future industries of strategic importance
 - Optimise the Innovation and Technology Venture Fund by redeploying \$1.5 billion to set up joint funds to invest in start-ups of strategic industries
