Government Funding Scheme Management Centre and The Biz Expands Easy Platform

Purpose

This paper aims to brief Members on the Government Funding Scheme Management Centre (GFSMC) and the Biz Expands Easy (BEE) Platform.

Government Funding Scheme Management Centre

- 2. Established in March 2021, GFSMC has been tasked with leading, integrating, cross-fertilising, and leveraging funding schemes to upgrade and transform industries. We proactively identify enterprise and industry needs, develop and enhance schemes, and serve the business community, particularly local Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs).
- 3. As the key implementer of Government funding schemes in Hong Kong, one of our main objectives is to reshape the funding scheme ecosystem in Hong Kong, and enable Hong Kong corporates to transform and expand their businesses with the help of well-matched subsidies, ultimately contributing to the economic growth of Hong Kong. Currently, we administer 10 Government funding schemes on behalf of two policy bureaux and four government departments:
 - a) Chinese Medicine Development Fund (CMDF)
 - b) Cleaner Production Partnership Programme (CPPP)
 - c) Dedicated Fund on Branding, Upgrading and Domestics Sales (BUD Fund)
 - d) Logistics Promotion Funding Scheme (LPFS)
 - e) Patent Application Grant (PAG)

- f) Pilot Subsidy Scheme for Third-party Logistics Service Providers (TPLSP)
- g) Professional Training on Smart and Green Logistics Scheme (PTSGLS)
- h) Recycling Fund (RF)
- i) Smart Traffic Fund (STF)
- j) Technology Voucher Programme (TVP).

Biz Expands Easy Platform

- 5. GFSMC has introduced the BEE 3-in-1 platform, consisting of BEE Web Platform, BEE ePass featuring Single Sign-on function, and the BEE@HKPC mobile app, in 2023 which is specifically designed to enable Hong Kong corporates to understand and apply for Government funding schemes more conveniently.
- 6. BEE is a one-stop platform providing integrated information for 25 Government funding schemes to foster digitalisation, cyber security, and smart and green living, and support for Hong Kong corporates, especially SMEs and startups, including a self-eligibility check kiosk, to facilitate users in exploring suitable funding schemes, accessing various funding resources and staying updated with the latest events and news of the funding schemes, catering to both professional and personal development.
- 7. Additionally, the BEE ePass allows enterprises to use a single user ID and password to access and manage multiple applications for funding schemes with secretariat support from the Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC). Since January 2024, the BEE ePass has supported the "iAM Smart" login service and allows users to conveniently log in to BEE ePass using "iAM Smart" without the need to provide username and password, enabling them to access and manage the applications for relevant funding schemes easily and enhancing the user experience. The BEE ePass also automatically transfers existing application details with an auto-fill registration form function, reducing the time spent on completing form for new application.

8. Through the BEE@HKPC mobile app, users could access all the functions of the BEE portal and also reserve 1-on-1 consultation to understand designated Government funding schemes.

Biz Expands Easy Square (BEE²)

- 9. In January 2024, GFSMC inaugurated BEE². This initiative is a collaborative community that unites Government Departments, Industry Associations, and Funding Applicants. Its primary objective is to establish a platform that enhances the accessibility of funding resources for Hong Kong corporations and startups, and also foster a network for applicants to share their successful experiences. Membership is available to enterprises and organisations.
- 10. BEE² members can obtain the latest funding news and event invitations, participate in events organised by HKPC, including sharing and delivering presentations. We will also display the logo of the members' brand or association in different marketing materials and promotional campaigns, as appropriate.
